#### ABOUT THE THEME:

The role of women in war has often been minimized. During the period of 1933-1945, the Nazi regime frequently subjected Jewish and non-Jewish women to particularly brutal persecution. Certain concentration camps were designated specifically for females. Women were vulnerable to physical abuse and used for sterilization experiments. Conversely, women were extremely important figures in rescue, resistance, and aid operations. Entries must include at least one citation.

#### GENERAL INFORMATION:

The competition is open to all public, private, parochial and home-schooled students, grades 6-12, in the greater Charleston area.

#### Follow the checklist to ensure a complete entry:

- One entry per student.
- **Entries without a securely attached entry form will be disqualified.**
- Entry form signed by student and parent must accompany entries
- Each entry must have a title that is relevant to the theme, "Women During The Holocaust"
- Winners will be chosen by a panel of judges based on adherence to the contest theme, technique and originality.
- **Entries must include one citation**

- Limit entries to 1000 words.
- Type and print written entries. Electronic copies will not be accepted.

#### Music and Performance Art:

- Collaborative entries are welcome.
- Format: YouTube or other online submission format.
- Entries should be under 3 minutes.
- Submit each entry with an entry form and an artist statement.
