

CECILIA SLOWINSKI SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- 1.) Return the completed application to your child's teacher by the posted deadline.
- 2.) **The applicant must be a student in good standing and a returning student to SOA. Upon returning in August for the school year following the summer study program and presenting the Booster Club with receipts showing payment to the summer program the student will be reimbursed the scholarship amount approved by the Booster Club Executive Board.**
- 3.) Funds **will not** be awarded to prior recipients of the Cecilia Slowinski Scholarship.
- 4.) Depending on the number of applications received, they will be forwarded to the secretary of the Booster Club board.
- 5.) The secretary/teacher will make a copy for each judge excluding the student's name and personal information.
- 6.) Each application will be assigned a cover sheet with a number.
- 7.) Judges will be School of the Arts faculty consisting of one high school teacher, one middle school teacher, and one artistic teacher from an area other than dance.
- 8.) Applications will then be distributed to each judge in individual packages, divided by middle school and high school, with a rating sheet.
- 9.) Judges will rate the applications in descending order on the rating sheet and return them to Ms. L. Cline head of the dance department.
- 10.) At the next convened Booster Club meeting the board will review the judge's choices. If a small number of applications are received, the board will decide on the number and amount awarded.
- 11.) Scholarships may be awarded in full or partial amounts. This will be determined by the amount of funds available.
- 12.) It is the desire of the dance faculty and the Booster Club Executive Board to award at least one middle school student and one high school student with a scholarship. However, because of funding, they will have the ultimate decision on the amount and number awarded.
- 13.) All applications along with the judge's rating forms will be kept on file for one year in the dance department.
